

LODGE RATES

2023-2024

All rates are expressed in USD.

There is a minimum stay of 3 nights for both groups and individuals.

GROUP RATES

The daily rate is \$95 per person for groups of 10-17 participants.

We provide retreat leaders with accommodation free of charge, either in the lodge or in our on-site staff quarters.

INDIVIDUAL RATES

These rates apply to individuals and groups of less than 10.

WHAT'S INCLUDED

The following items are included in the above rates.

- Transfers in and out from the nearest access point at Wharton
- Breakfast, including tea, coffee and juice, homemade sourdough breads with assorted jams from the farm, eggs, bacon, yogurt, granola, milk, fruit salad and pastries.
Breakfast and other meals (available for purchase) are made with fresh produce from the garden and as many locally-sourced, organic ingredients as possible.
- Exclusive access to the lodge and surrounding 260-hectare property located within the Río Azul Natural Protected Area
- Unlimited use of wellness facilities including wood-fired hot tubs, Finnish sauna, cold plunge pool and open-air yoga deck (bring your own yoga mats)
- Private access to the beach on the Río Azul river
- Direct access to the trailhead for the Cajón del Azul and many other mountain huts
- Linens, towels and robes*
- Biodegradable vegan soap, shampoo and conditioner
- Wireless internet

ADD-ONS

The following are available for purchase (not included in the above rates).

- Lunch and dinner*
- Drinks
- Guided trekking and outdoor recreation activities
- Massage therapy
- Additional transfers

*Both dine-in and packed to go lunches are available for purchase. The cost for these is \$20 and \$15 per person, respectively. Dinner is also available for purchase for \$30 per person.

RESERVATIONS

We require a 30% deposit via bank transfer or PayPal in order to reserve the requested dates.

Please note that there is a 5% surcharge for deposits made via PayPal. The balance is to be paid upon arrival in cash or by bank transfer. Cash payments are to be made in dollars or the equivalent amount of Argentine pesos at the "blue rate" at the time of payment.

CANCELLATION POLICY

A prorated refund of the initial deposit is available when a reservation is canceled at least 15 days prior to arrival. The percentage to be refunded is as follows:

For reservations canceled
60 or more days prior to
arrival: 20%

For reservations canceled
30 or more days prior to
arrival: 10%

For reservations canceled
15 or more days prior to
arrival: 5%

There is no refund for reservations canceled less than 15 days prior to arrival.

Transfers in and out: The transfer in and out from Wharton is included in the above rates.

Transfers from other locations can be arranged for a fee.

Note for groups: A transfer in and out from Wharton for all participants at a previously agreed upon time is included in the above rate. We can provide multiple transfers from Wharton for your group if necessary, however please keep in mind that there is an additional fee for any transfers requested before or after the agreed upon time.

Retreat leaders are welcome to arrive 1-2 days in advance. The transfer in and out from Wharton for retreat leaders is provided separately from the rest of the group at no extra charge.

HELPFUL TIPS

Use of hot tubs and sauna: You are welcome to use the hot tubs and sauna at any time, however as these are wood-fired units, we do need to know a day in advance if you plan to use them so that we can heat them accordingly and have them ready to go at the desired time. We provide towels and robes for use in this area, which also includes a cold plunge pool.

*We request that you bring a towel or blanket to use at the river and for any outdoor activities as ours are not to be used for this purpose.

Drinking water: We are fortunate to have some of the best drinking water on the planet here at La Confluencia. As such, it's not necessary to bring bottled water with you. Our drinking water comes from a mountain stream and is tested regularly to ensure quality. This same water can be found in our showers and in the kitchen.
